


Figure 1. Government Owned / Sponsored Model

Figure 2. Private Ownership Model




Figure 3A. Single Non-Profit Ownership Model




Figure 3B. Collaborative Non-Profit Ownership Model






Figure 3C. Co-operative Non-Profit Ownership Model
