



Disaster Relief Special Enrollment Period (SEP) Now Available

Additional Health Coverage Enrollment Opportunity for Uninsured Coloradans

The State of Colorado has declared disaster emergencies related to active wildfires across the state. As a result, a **Disaster Relief Special Enrollment Period (SEP)** is available for uninsured Colorado residents. This SEP provides an opportunity to enroll in health coverage outside of the regular Open Enrollment period.

Important Dates

July 14, 2026 – September 12, 2026

Who Is Eligible?

The Disaster Relief SEP is available to:

- Uninsured Colorado residents
- Individuals who need health coverage outside of the standard Open Enrollment period

Coverage Options

Eligible residents can enroll in health insurance through:

- **Connect for Health Colorado**
- **Colorado Connect**

What You Need to Know

- No documentation is required to use this Special Enrollment Period.
- Individuals may self-attest that they are uninsured.
- Coverage begins on the **first day of the month following plan selection.**
- Financial assistance may be available for those who qualify.

Don't Miss This Limited-Time Opportunity

Uninsured Coloradans have a limited window to enroll in health coverage through this Disaster Relief Special Enrollment Period. Explore your coverage options and enroll before the deadline.
